

Greetings Quilter!

Please read & check-off each line to be sure your quilt top is ready for longarming and avoid delays/additional fees.

PIKE COUNTY QUILT COMPANY QUILT PREP CHECKLIST 2026:

- _____ Call Julie ahead of time to discuss your quilt (570-507-0196).
- _____ Check quilt top for missed or loose seams; trim threads.
- _____ Backing & batting 12 inches longer and 12 inches wider than quilt top
(for example : A 100 x 100 quilt top needs a 112 x 112 backing and batting).*
- _____ Quality batting (must be scrim or needle punched).
- _____ Quilt top pressed neatly to avoid additional pressing fee.
- _____ Quilt backing pressed and neatly squared.
- _____ Directional or one-way design fabrics should be marked with a note safety pinned to the top stating **TOP** on both backing and quilt top.
- _____ Name on batting package and any bag, hangers, etc. to be returned with your quilt.
- _____ Intake form completed & included with quilt. Snap a photo of the Intake form for your records.

* Quilt backings with additional/multiple piecing or secondary designs will be charged accordingly. Centering and or exact placement is not possible. **Please call Julie prior to drop-off to discuss a backing with special considerations.**

CHARGES:

- Most edge-to-edge pantographs are priced at \$.0225 per square inch which includes thread. (Multiply the length X width of your quilt to find the number of square inches then multiply the total square inches X .0225 to determine approximate cost. There is a minimum charge of \$40.00 for quilting.
- Backings that require squaring, pressing or special placement will incur an additional charge.
- Please make a note on the INTAKE SHEET if you would like your quilt trimmed to one-inch larger once it has been longarmed. This service is available for an additional charge of \$10.00 per quilt.
- 6% PA sales tax will be added to the total. Cash or check payable to JULIE MOTT is due once your quilt is ready for pick up.
